Proverbs 19:18

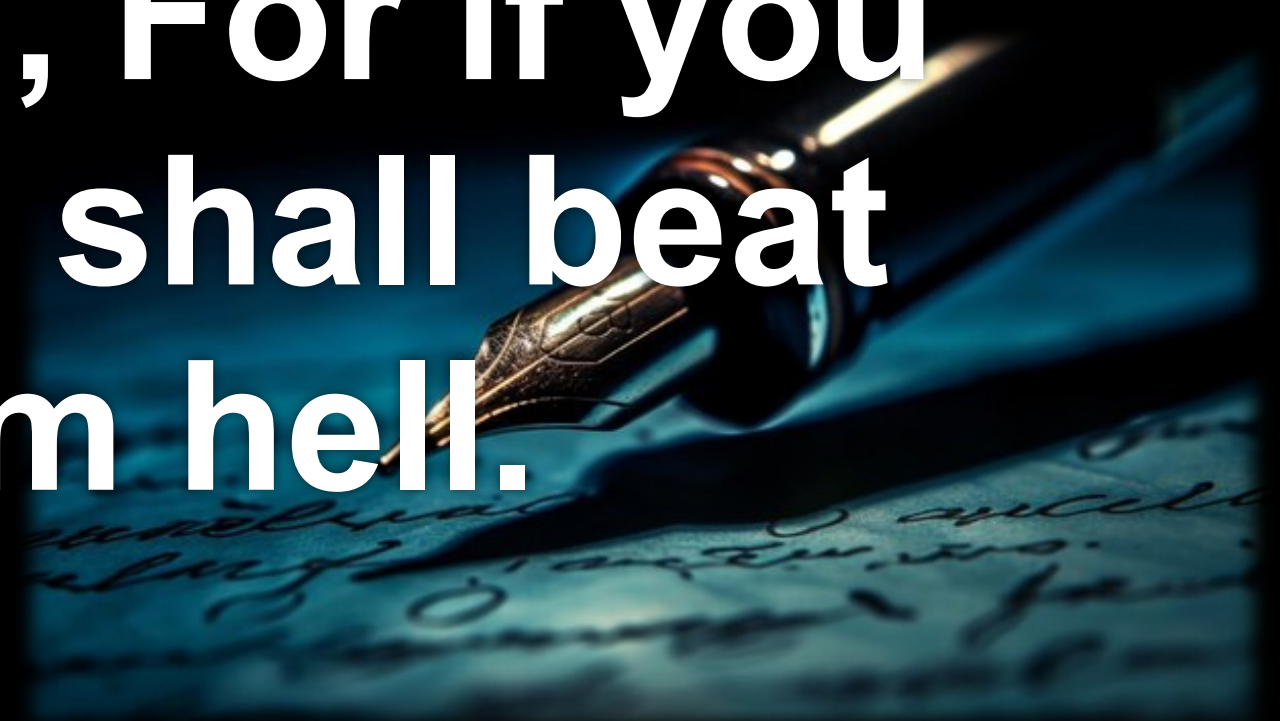
**Chasten your son while there is hope,
