- multiple colors of face paint
- glitter safe for skin
- 5-7 paint brushes of varying size
- 4 boxes of tissues
- · pack of baby wipes
- roll of paper towels
- 2 water pitchers
- small tumbler cups
- 4 packs of makeup sponges
- bag of cotton balls
- small baby powder
- small baby shampoo
- · pack of paper plates
- trash can
- plastic hand mirrors
- table
- 5-7 chairs
- 2 hand towels
- printed out picture
- hair clips/headband
- music stand
- sign

Attraction Instructions: Try to keep the time limit to one child per 5-10 minutes. This is a very popular attraction, so expect high traffic and lines. Try and get to know the children in the time you have with them. Talk about the games they have played, what they have learned, and encourage them to visit the Gospel Castle. We strive for cleanliness, and the prevention of the spread of germs, so please follow the cleaning procedures during and between each child.

## Face Painting Procedure

- 1. Child sits and face painting choice is established
- 2. Using the wood stick painter chooses colors needed and applies to pallet plate
- 3. After face painting is completed, painter cleanses station
- 4. Throw away paper towel, wood stick, and sponge
- 5. Wash brushes in soapy water
- 6. Put brushes into alcohol cup
- 7. Pour clean water and soapy water into dump pitcher/bucket
- 8. Throw away paper cups
- 9. Reset station Replace paper towel, cup. Put out sponge, brushes, paper stick. Refill clean cup and soapy cup

## Other important information

- 1. Please only paint options on the paper given
- 2. Do not dip paint brushes into face paints directly
- 3. Use hand sanitizer between each child
